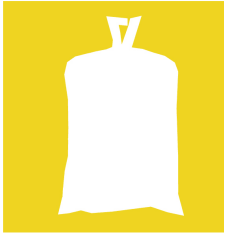


# How do I separate the garbage properly:



In the **residual waste can** belongs non-recyclable waste such as: sanitary items, soiled paper, diapers, vacuum cleaner bags, old wallpaper, old pots, street sweepings, china, worn shoes, hats, bags, textiles, cat litter, dog excrements, cigarette butts, coal ash, etc.



In the **yellow bag** belongs: plastics such as plastic bags, plastic wrap, plastic bottles e.g. from shampoos, cosmetics, detergents, clean styrofoam packaging. Metals such as food and drink cans, aluminium (e.g. lids of yogurt cups) bottle caps, completely empty spray cans. Composite materials such as juice and milk cartons, coffee packaging, vacuum packs.



In the **bio can** belongs: garden waste such as leaves, lawn clippings, weeds, plants. Kitchen waste such as leftover food, vegetables and fruit, coffee and tea filters, eggshells, bread, banana and citrus peels, raw and cooked food also raw meat and fish scraps. Other organic waste such as potted plants, nutshells, wood ash in small quantities, feathers, newspaper for wrapping food scraps etc.



In the **paper can** belongs: clean paper e.g. newspapers, magazines, cardboard boxes, wrapping paper, gift wrap (but not gift foils), books, envelopes, food wrappings made of paper or cardboard.



In the **glass containers** belong: non-returnable glass bottles, pickle and jelly jars, clean and without content. Pay attention to the colour sorting. Glass that is neither clear nor brown or green, e.g. red or blue glass, should be put in the container for green glass.



The **hazardous waste truck** comes once a month to marked stops in every community. You can bring e.g. adhesives, any type of battery, cooking oil, oil stained rags, used oil, energy-saving light bulbs, fluorescent lights (do not break them), nail polish, paints and varnishes, small electrical appliances, etc.
